Packed Lunches Student Survey




The survey aims to gain information on the lunch packaging utilised by students. A fifth question was set to obtain information on how much of the lunches are being actually eaten by students.

The pie charts below illustrate the results obtained.


Lunch Packaging




How often do you replace your lunchbox?




How often do you replace your water bottle?
