School Bags

- The official school case and school outing bag are no longer compulsory for students. However, school cases bought must be **either dark blue or black**. Satchels on wheels must also be dark blue or black with a retractable handle.

Girls are allowed to come to school in full P.E. kit ONLY on days when they have P.E., PSCD or Drama lessons, or for specific school outings.

Necessary disciplinary measures will be taken against girls who breach school uniform regulations.

IMPORTANT SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS

- Blue school shoes: no high heels, wedges or 'ballerina' pumps allowed.
- White running shoes: no fancy trimmings or coloured shoe laces; only discreet brand names are allowed in colour.
- School uniforms must be smart: frayed cardigan cuffs and faded uniforms are not allowed.
- Skirt lengths must be decent; not shorter than 5 cms above the knee.
- School trousers are optional; school skirts must be worn on official school outings and functions.
- Students must wear their blazer to enter and leave school at all times during winter uniform periods when not in tracksuit.
- Blazer worn over tracksuit is allowed in cold weather. Alternatively the navy blue school anorak which is optional can be worn.
- White polo necks under school shirt or polo shirt are only allowed in cold weather.
- Students may neither enter nor leave school in their P.E. shorts at any time.
- School tights cannot be worn with summer uniform.

The following School Uniform Regulations from the 'Code of Behaviour' must be respected at all times:

Section B - School Uniform:

1. Complete School uniform is to be worn every day during school hours, outings and examination times except on occasions when special permission has been given. Skirt lengths are to be decent. Shabby, torn and faded items of uniform are to be replaced. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
2. The correct sportswear and shoes are to be worn for P.E.
3. Make-up, nail extensions, nail transfers and/or nail polish are not allowed. Girls will be asked to remove them/it immediately.
4. Jewellery in general is not allowed, but one pair of small matching ear studs may be worn, as well as a Cross or Holy Medal on a thin gold or silver chain.
5. Body piercing of any sort is strictly forbidden. Studs may only be worn on the ear lobe.
6. Hairstyles unbecoming the school uniform are strictly forbidden. Hair is to be kept tidy and tied back if it is long. No extravagant hair colouring is allowed. Simple hair bands matching the school colours may be worn, but fancy or coloured slides, jaw clips or other hair ornaments are not allowed.
7. **ALL UNIFORM AND OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS ARE TO BE CLEARLY MARKED.** Any unmarked items that are found and remain unclaimed will be disposed of at the end of the scholastic year.
